Manuia le Vaiaso o le Gagana Sāmoa – Happy Samoan Language Week!

The 2024 theme for Sāmoan Language Week is Tautua i le alofa, manuia le lumana'i – Serve in love for a blessed future. This theme derives from the overarching Language Week Series theme for 2024, 'Sustainability'. It emphasises the importance of embracing the Sāmoan language as a means to strengthen cultural identity, preserve heritage, and build a sense of belonging

Gagana Sāmoa is the second most spoken language in Auckland and the third most spoken in New Zealand - we have a number of Gagana Sāmoa speakers in your school. The Sāmoan language has many components. There is simple Sāmoan, and there is more complex Sāmoan. There is everyday language and then there is respectful language. There is language specific to young people, and then language that pertains to chiefs and orators.
