



TICKETS

EARLY-BIRD TICKETS AND TOKENS SALES WILL BE OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL HALL ON WEDNESDAY 13 NOVEMBER AND THURSDAY 14 NOVEMBER BETWEEN 2.45PM AND 3.15PM. THE EARLY-BIRD COST IS \$3 PER CHILD. \$4 DOOR SALES WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE ON THE NIGHT.

DISCO TOKENS

\$1 IS EQUIVALENT TO 1 TOKEN, OFFICIAL TOKENS CAN ONLY BE USED FOR PURCHASING ITEMS AND ACTIVITIES INSIDE. WE ADVISE THAT YOU PRE-PURCHASE YOUR TOKENS PRIOR TO COMING TO THE DISCO TO AVOID LENGTHY QUEUES. EFTPOS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE NIGHT TO PURCHASE TOKENS IF REQUIRED.

PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN

PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN ARE ABLE TO ATTEND THE DISCO FOR FREE. NOTE THE EVENT WILL HAVE LOUD MUSIC, BE DARKENED TO ALLOW NEON LIGHTS TO GLOW AND THERE MAY BE STROBE LIGHTING USED AT TIMES.

HOW TO AVOID QUEUES ON THE NIGHT

TIMING OF THE EVENT

DOORS OPEN AT 4:50PM - INCLUDING THE PRE-SALES AND DOOR SALES LINES. DISCO WILL RUN THROUGHOUT THE 4:50PM -7:00PM TIME PERIOD. RAFFLES WILL BE DRAWN AND ANNOUNCED AT 6:30PM, LAST SONG PLAYED AT 7:00PM. EVERYTHING INSIDE WILL BE AVAILABLE THE WHOLE TWO HOURS OR UNTIL THE ITEMS SELL OUT.

Slip on clothing

Slip on clothing that covers as much skin as possible, such as a top with a collar and long sleeves, trousers, or long shorts or skirts. Fabrics with a tighter weave and darker colours will give you better protection from the sun.



Slip into shade

Slip into the shade of a leafy tree, building or shade sail. Plan your outdoor activities for early or later in the day when the sun's UV levels are lower.



Slop on sunscreen

Slop on plenty of broad-spectrum, water-resistant sunscreen of at least SPF 30. An average-sized adult needs a teaspoon of sunscreen for their head and neck, each limb and for the front and the back of the body. Apply 20 minutes before going outside and reapply every two hours, or after being in water or sweating.



Wrap on sunglasses

Choose close fitting, wrap around style sunglasses. Not all sunglasses protect against UV radiation, so always check the label for the sun protection rating.


